Class Title	Curved Piecing without Pins II: Piecing Accu-Quilt cut Winding Ways
Type of Class	Hands-on cutting and piecing technique workshop
Time needed	3-4 hours
Student Limit	20
Classroom Equipment	Sewing machines with ¼" presser feet, Design wall or foam board for pinning up samples
Class Description	Learn to piece those fabulous curves using an easy pin-less technique. We will cut Accu-Quilt winding ways blocks and learn to piece these versatile curved shapes without pins. If you thought you could not do curves this workshop will change your mind, while you create a great table runner project.
Benefits of Class	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learn to use the Accu-Quilt cutter to cut curved patches • You will learn a precision piecing technique which can be applied to other projects with curved seams. • Lots of shortcuts and tips for cutting and piecing you won't find in books. • Use pre-cuts and fast cutting techniques to get right to the sewing. • Project pattern and practice block is provided in the class fee.
Supplies Needed	Basic sewing supplies, thin glass head pins, long bent-nose tweezers (available for sale in class), 2 light FQ's and 2-4 coordinating med/dark FQ's If you have a Go! Cutter or winding ways die you may bring them
