Class Title	Diamond Stars Jelly Roll Quilt
Type of Class	Wall or Crib quilt project with 60 degree diamond template
Time needed	6 hours or a full day (or two 3-hour blocks)
Student Limit	25
Classroom Equipment	Sewing machines with quarter inch foot rotary cutting mats, acrylic rulers, irons and ironing boards
Class Description	Learn to piece beautiful star blocks without any set-in seams! This precision cutting and piecing class teaches you to make 60 degree diamond stars in rows that are easily pieced to make any size quilt. Perfect project for using up stash or using one of those fabulous jelly rolls you have collected. Learn tips and tricks for working with pre-cuts, rotary cutters, and templates, and machine piecing diamonds.
