Teaching Proposal

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Class Title	One Patch Workshop Using Charm Packs: Diamonds, Half Hex, Tumblers
Type of Class	Hands-on workshop: Precision cutting and piecing
Time needed	4-6 hours
Student Limit	25
Classroom Equipment	Sewing machines with ¼" foot Cutting mats, irons & ironing boards
Class Description	Turn a charm pack into a fabulous table mat and add an easy scalloped border – all on the machine, with no hand piecing. No set-in seams! Learn to cut and sew bias binding like a pro.
Benefits of Class	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A charm pack project which can be completed in a day. • Beginner project suitable for every skill level. • Introduces techniques of rotary cutting with acrylic templates, and creating scalloped borders • Includes tips on how to create bias binding, and how to bind curved edges perfectly • Fun, scrappy project that can be expanded (later) to create larger projects. • Few supplies needed making it perfect for a class.
Supplies Needed	1 Charm Pack (40 5" squares) 1 yard coordinating fabric for border (half hex) 1 yard background fabric for (diamonds) FQ for bias binding (1 for each project) Small Rotating cutting mat (optional but very helpful) Rotary cutter Small Flannel-back table cloth or piece of batting for a design wall Basic Sewing Supplies
Kit Fee	\$20 or \$8 per template
Kit Contents	Small Half Hex acrylic template, diamond template, tumbler template, and instructions/pattern
Optional Items for sale	\$18.00 Small rotating cutting mat \$5.00 45mm Titanium rotary cutter blades
Other considerations	Choose one shape (half hex, diamond, or tumbler) to complete one project. Choose all 3 shapes to learn techniques for all three shapes with completion of 3 partial projects. One charm pack per shape. 3 charm packs to make all 3 projects.
