Class Title	One Patch Workshop Using Charm Packs: Diamonds, Half Hex, Tumblers
Type of Class	Hands-on workshop: Precision cutting and piecing
Time needed	4-6 hours
Student Limit	25
Classroom Equipment	Sewing machines with ¼ " foot Cutting mats, irons & ironing boards
Class Description	Turn a charm pack into a fabulous table mat and add an easy scalloped border – all on the machine, with no hand piecing.  No set-in seams! Learn to cut and sew bias binding like a pro.
Benefits of Class	<ul> <li>A charm pack project which can be completed in a day.</li> <li>Beginner project suitable for every skill level.</li> <li>Introduces techniques of rotary cutting with acrylic templates, and creating scalloped borders</li> <li>Includes tips on how to create bias binding, and how to bind curved edges perfectly</li> <li>Fun, scrappy project that can be expanded (later) to create larger projects.</li> <li>Few supplies needed making it perfect for a class.</li> </ul>
