## Version 1 & 2 Cutting List for Stars


Each complete star has 4 diamonds: 1 each of sienna marble, slate, quartz lite, & sandstone in one colorway.

Each complete star has 2 quartz triangles and 2 sandstone triangles.

The <u>star layout illustration</u> (right) provides a number for each star. The <u>strip cutting chart</u> (below) shows how many total diamonds and triangles to cut from each 2-1/2" strip.

**Version 1: White background** 72 diamonds, 84 triangles

**Version 2: Black background** 72 diamonds, 84 triangles








## Version 1 & 2 Color Layout Guide

Version 1 with the off-white background is shown in the Layout Guide. If you are making the version with the black background, replace the off-white diamonds and triangles with black. List of colorways for each star, in order from top to bottom, listed below the chart.



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## **Version 1 & 2 Layout and Assembly Instructions**

- On a design wall or large flat area arrange the quilt center star diamonds and triangles and the background diamonds and triangles. Arrange the colors in any position of your choice, or follow the layout diagram on the next page.
- 2. Treat all partial diamonds and triangles as full diamonds and triangles. They will be trimmed off after the quilt top is assembled.
- 3. Once all the shapes are arranged take a digital photo of the arrangement and print it out (if possible) as a reference.
- 4. Stack all the diamonds and triangles in each row in order from top to bottom, and carefully place in a zip top bag. Label the bag with the row number. You will have 18 bags.
- 5. Working in one vertical row at a time, sew the diamonds and triangles together in pairs as shown in Fig. 9. Row 1 and 2 are shown here.
- 6. Be sure the shapes are rotated the correct way. Unsew any pairs that get reversed.
- 7. Chain piece the pairs in each row. Then sew two pairs together until all of the pairs are now sewn in sets of 4.
- 8. Continue to sew sets of 4 into one set of 8, and one set of 5. Then sew the two sets together. Press the seams in one direction.
- 9. Repeat steps 5-8 for the next vertical row. Press the seams in the opposite direction.
- 10. Join these first two vertical rows together matching seams. Press this long seam open. Label these 2 rows with the row numbers and set aside.
- 11. Join the next two vertical rows as directed in steps 5-10.
- 12. Continue to sew the quilt top into pairs of rows until all rows have been constructed. There will be 9 pairs of rows.
- 13. Sew all the rows together, matching seams, to complete the top.
- 14. If using the color arrangement shown here, use the illustration on the next page to select the remaining colors for each row.
- 15. If you created your own color arrangement, refer to your photo taken in step 3.
- 16. Fuse a black circle to the center of each star and edge stitch it in place using a narrow zig-zag or blanket stitch and matching thread.
