Fabric Requirements - (whole quilt)

- 2-1/2 yards warm tan (background 1)
- 3/4 yard grayish tan (background 2)
- 2 yards ivory tan lite (background 3)
- 2-1/2 yards black
- 1 yard teal
- 1-1/2 yards aqua
- 1/2 yard bright yellow
- 1-1/2 yards bright golden yellow
- 1/2 yard bright orange
- 1 yard bright red-orange
- 1/4 yard red
- 1/2 yard bright green
- 1/8 yard light lime green
- 1/8 yard dark green
- 3/8 yard dark teal
- 1/2 yard bright blue
- 1/8 yard rust

Additional Supplies Required

- 2 yards of fusible web (Lite Steam A Seam 2)
- 80" x 80" batting
- Applique pressing sheet of Fusamat
- Bent nose tweezers
- 1/4" bias maker
- Stabilizer
- Matching thread
- Roxanne Fabric Glue

Techniques used in this quilt

1. Raw edge machine applique using fusible web for all applique blocks.
2. Foundation paper piecing used for middle and border setting blocks.
3. Traditional rotary cutting and piecing for chain blocks and solid borders.
