**Sept 13<sup>th</sup> from 10:00 to 11:30 am** at the Ingram Field (west of the City Office).



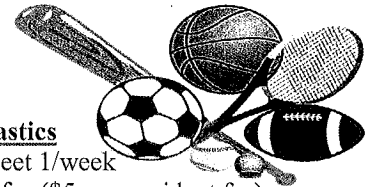
