## Elk Ridge Disaster Drill Saturday, April 13, 9 AM

This disaster drill will be the City's attempt to communicate with the entire city (YOU), so your help will be essential. When the disaster drill begins at 9:00 AM, you need to remember to place the **colored sheet** outside your door (green for no injuries) and check your neighbor on either side, then report to your **group captain**. If you want to see how the city responds to a disaster, you can report to your Neighborhood Staging Area to observe and offer assistance where needed. Let's make this a family event where you take the time to review procedures with your children.

**CERT TEAMS:** Each Team Leader receives check-ins from CERT members in the Neighborhood. He/She then calls in a report to Stephanie Taylor at the EOC.

**COMMUNICATIONS:** Each Communications Leader checks in with Paul Jones at the EOC. Other HAM operators check in at your staging area in case you are needed.

**NEIGHBORHOODS:** Each Neighborhood Chair receives calls from Group Captains & accounts for those not reporting in. The NC then calls in a report to Mike Turner at the EOC.

Remember--- Most people become interested in disaster preparedness After the disaster. We have now had a little taste of that, so let's get prepared BEFORE a major disaster strikes.
