Enough airspace to fulfill the annual municipal waste disposal needs for 41 people!

21,719 kWh of Electricity

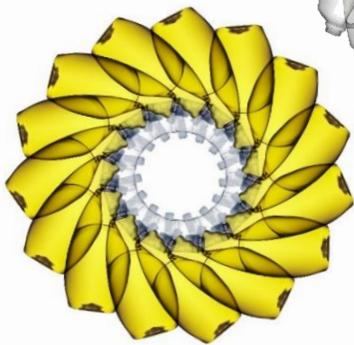
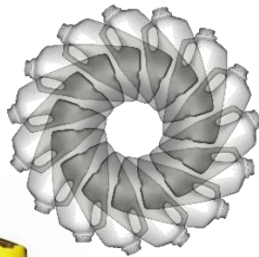
Enough power to fulfill the annual electricity needs of 2 homes!
