## MEETING MINUTES:

1. **MEETING CALL TO ORDER:** Mayor Flitton called the meeting to order.

**PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:** Led by Mayor Flitton

2. **DISCUSSION ON NUISANCE ORDINANCE:** (00:01:00)

Presenter: Kristi Bell

- Kristi explained that she made all the corrections and put in all the suggestions that she received via email and thanked the Council for their comments.
- The Council reviewed the ordinance and asked for any questions.
- Michelle Roberts stated that she really felt strongly that it be written that it is complaint driven.
- It was discussed adding in Section Five A-C: "The City will respond to all formal written requests".
- And in Section Five A-E: Inspection: Consequent to a "formal written" nuisance complaint by a resident of Uintah City.
- Section Two A last line was changed to "or in any way renders a person insecure in life or the use of property".
- An in Section Two A-1; the first line to "An act which affects a person in any way." Taking the plural out of the complaint.
- It was discussed to remove in Section Seven B #6 "Each such vehicle/vessel shall be located on gravel, cement, or hard surface only". This will need to be reviewed and have continued conversation with the Planning Commission on this subject, then if needed we can amend the ordinance.
- Jerry Smith had a question in Section four; should we include steel portable units that residents are bringing in for storage in their yards. Mayor Flitton suggested that this topic be addressed with the Planning Commission and our continuing conversation with the issue of approved surfaces.
- The Mayor and Council thanked Kristi for all her efforts and time spent on this project; great job!
