In November 2020, we recycled 6 tons of cans, bottles, paper, and cardboard.

Recycling these materials will save the following resources:

87 Mature Trees

Represents enough saved timber resources to produce 1,478,600 sheets of printing and copy paper!

16 Cubic Yards of Landfill Airspace

Enough airspace to fulfill the annual municipal waste disposal needs for 17 people!

20,060 Kw-Hrs of Electricity

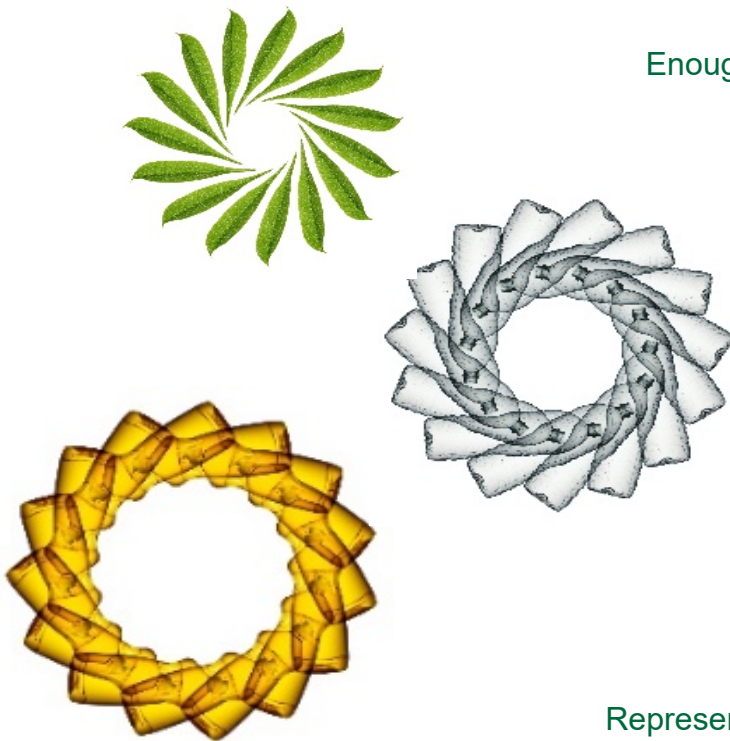
Enough power to fulfill the annual electricity needs of 1 homes!

Avoided 21 Metric Tons (MTCO₂E) of GHG Emissions

21,471 Gallons of Water
