1. **MEETING CALL TO ORDER:** Mayor Flitton called the meeting to order.

3. **DISCUSSION/ACTION ON RESOLUTION NO. 17-1208-COURT; A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE INTENT OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF UINTAH CITY TO ENTER INTO AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH WEBER COUNTY TO HOLD WEBER COUNTY'S JUSTICE COURT IN UINTAH CITY:** (00:00:31)

Presenter: Mayor Flitton

- Mayor Flitton explained that the Judge has visited with him a couple of times regarding our intent to host the unincorporated Weber County's Court for the upper valley. We already have the Huntsville City limits; with this we would include the entire upper valley in our court. This means at least 50% more volume which increases our revenue.
- It was discussed that we might have to hold court more than twice a month to accommodate the parking issues that might arise due to the increase volume.
- Mayor Flitton asked the Council if they had any concerns with this.
- Gordon Cutler asked if we have paid Roy City back for what they charged us to take on the Huntsville Court. Mayor Flitton advised that has been taken care of.
- Michelle Roberts asked if it would impact the budget with having to pay the Judge more for the additional court days. Mayor Flitton advised it would be covered in the increased revenues.
- Jerry Smith asked if we hold court more frequently would it increase the budget for what we pay the bailiffs. Mayor Flitton advised no.
- Gordon Cutler motioned to approve the resolution expressing the intent of the Mayor and City Council of Uintah City to enter into an Interlocal agreement with Weber County to hold Weber County's Justice Court in Uintah City.
- Mayor Flitton explained that this is just our intent not the Interlocal agreement. The Judge will take this document to the meeting with the Administrators of the Courts on December 18th, 2017.
- Jerry Smith seconded the motion.
