

The City of Uintah is currently accepting applications for one (1) vacancy and (2) alternates for the Planning Commission. The Planning Commission is an advisory body to the City Council on matters pertaining to planning and land use.

Typically, Commissioners serve four-year terms, with the possibility of being appointed to consecutive terms. The Commission meets in the Uintah City Council Chambers at 7 p.m. on the fourth Tuesday of every month.

The Planning Commission will elect one of its members to act as chairperson and another member to act as vice-chairperson for a period of one year. The chairperson and/or vice chairperson may be reelected for successive terms each year. The chairperson will preside at all meetings of the Planning Commission unless absent, in which case the vice chairperson will preside.


Duties and responsibilities will include; attend regular meetings, review and provide input on ordinances related to land use and development, review land use requests such as subdivisions and annexations with regard to the City's General Plan and City ordinances, make recommendations to City Council regarding land use decisions and serve in an advisory capacity for long-range planning and community development issues.

City residency is required. A stipend of \$30.00 per month is paid to each Planning Commissioner. If elected, the Planning Commission Chair will receive a stipend of \$200 per month. 
