RECYCLING

A few citizens have asked recently if our recycling is actually being recycled or if it's being dumped with the regular garbage. A quick reassurance that our efforts to recycle are not in vain. Waste Management has assured me that they do not dump the recycling with the regular garbage unless there was some sort of contamination and it couldn't be sent to the recycling center. VIPS

The Weber County Sheriff's Office is looking for qualified citizens to assist patrol deputies in serving our community through a Volunteers In Police Service (VIPS) program.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES

VIPS can expect to do the following duties routinely:

- To observe and report crimes or suspicious activities to Deputies while on Patrol Shifts
- To attend meetings and trainings
- To deter and prevent crime
- To provide a sense of observation for businesses and citizens
- To patrol city neighborhoods, parks, churches, business districts, parking lots etc.

QUALIFICATIONS

- At least 21 years of age
- Must be a resident of, or a business owner in, a WCSO contract city (Farr West, Hooper, Huntsville, Marriott-Slaterville, Plain City, Uintah, Washington Terrace, West Haven) or Unincorporated Weber County
- Good moral character, with no convictions, as determined by a background check and drug test.
- Good driving record.
