Summary Recommendations: This report is for informational purposes as part of the Fire Department’s Monthly Report to the City Council.



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

- A. **Topic:** Fire Department Monthly Update, per City Ordinance 5-1B-3 (E).






STATUS OF SIGNIFICANT ISSUES DEPARTMENT IS ADDRESSING

- * Fire Inspections – potential delays due to lack of certified Fire Inspectors
- * Reorganization of the FD was approved by Mayor Cutler and began to take effect in late August 2019. Some fallout from this decision continues; however, there has been a significant improvement to FD morale since the reorganization.
- * Staffing – will continue to be an issue:
 - Only one Uintah City Resident is currently on the department
 - Members leaving to obtain better pay from nearby Volunteer departments
