What is a “General Plan?”

A **General Plan** is a document that helps decision makers in the City insure that what the residents want in the City **is included** and what is not wanted **is kept out** so that the City will be like you want it to be.

To find out what you and your neighbors envision your City to be, a team of seniors from the University of Utah with majors in City planning are inviting all share our stories and what we value in our community. Please be aware and support their efforts in the following ways.
