## A RESOLUTION OF UINTAH CITY COUNCIL AMEDING, ADOPTING, AND SETTING FEES FOR THE UINTAH CITY CEMETERY

**BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED**, by the City Council of Uintah City, State of Utah, as follows:

**WHEREAS**, the City of Uintah provides certain municipal services to both entities and its citizens who request or require those services; and

**WHEREAS**, the provision of those services generally provides benefit to all people and entities residing in or conducting business in the City of Uintah; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds it is necessary and desirable to amend certain cemetery related fees and finds that it is in the best interests of the citizens of Uintah City to do so;
