

## **NOTICE:**

### **Uintah Ordinance, Title 7, Chapter 4 concerning the Uintah City Cemetery was revised February, 2019.**

**Please refer in particular to Title 7, Chapter 4, Section 18,  
paragraph K:** Benches, Chairs and Structures are NOT permitted.

#### **Title 7, Chapter 4, Section 21, Paragraph A, 1-6:**

- 1) The planting of any vegetation is strictly prohibited.
- 2) Flowers will remain at the graveside for a period of one week from the time of the burial service. Flowers may remain longer if determined by the cemetery staff that they hold their value.
- 3) Artificial flowers may be placed in the cemetery on the grave markers but only to allow, and not interfere with, routine cemetery maintenance. Cemetery personnel will remove any artificial flowers that appear unsightly or cause problems with regular maintenance.
- 4) Glass containers or anything made of glass, solar lights or decorations with wire anchors or stakes are strictly prohibited.
- 5) Flower containers May through October must be kept within the headstone space. Shephard hooks, baskets, wreaths and other adornments outside the headstone mow strip found to be causing problems with maintenance or the safety of cemetery personnel will be removed and discarded promptly without notice.
- 6) Cemetery personnel will remove any items that, in the sole judgment, appear unsightly or cause problems with regular maintenance.
