

FAMILY ABUSE

PHYSICAL ABUSE

When a person harms another human being physically. This can cause injury.

- Punching
- Beating
- Biting
- Burning
- Hitting

SEXUAL ABUSE

Any type of sexual violation against a person of any age.

- Sexual intercourse
- Inappropriate touching or fondling
- Child pornography
- Lude acts in front of the person
- Engaging in child prostitution

EMOTIONAL ABUSE

Nonphysical harm but harms the other person mentally.

- Excessive criticism
- Blaming
- Telling the person they are not loved or wanted

NEGLIGENCE

Ignoring or depriving a person of their necessary need such as:

- Food
- Shelter
- Proper hygiene
