

PLANNING COMMISSION MEETING

March 17, 1983

Minutes of the regular meeting of the Box Elder County Planning Commission held Thursday, March 17, 1983, at 7:00 p.m. Members present were Glen Nelson and Charles Kimber, with ex-officio member County Surveyor Denton Beecher.

There was not a quorum present so there could not be any action taken on matters presented before the Commission. Those present did listen to Craig and Natalie Corbett of Tremonton.

Craig explained their proposal to the Commission and since Mr. Nelson was absent last meeting, he went over their original proposal and added that if they can get permission to locate their mobile home on their lot as a temporary permit and do not have to construct a permanent foundation under the mobile home, they would sign a legal agreement to the following:

1. Not sell the ground without first removing the mobile home.
2. They would have their home built within two growing seasons after their home in Tremonton is sold. If the home is not built within the time specified, they would then place a permanent foundation under the mobile home.
3. They would landscape their lot and keep it in a good looking condition.

Craig said they would like to request this type of a variance and plead that the Commission consider their request.

REQUEST AND CONSENT FOR VACATION OF COUNTY ROAD

A Request and Consent for Vacation of a County Road, signed by Larsen, Jeppson, and Reeders, was presented for the Commission to approve. The dirt road was severed by the construction of the I-15 freeway and now simply dead ends. It is located on 800 North at I-15 to 2600 West St. The two members in attendance agreed with the request.
