

Rail Fence - Beginning Quilt Class Supply list

This quilt is throw quilt size (about 58" x 58")

In the **first class**, learn how to select your fabrics for color and value, rotary cut for strip, ¼ inch piecing, and how to make your blocks. ***Note: fabric requirements are based on 42" fabric width.

Supplies needed:

- Start Quilting by Alex Anderson Book
- 100% Cotton Fabric***:
 - ¼ yard of Three different fabrics in a "Light" Value
 - ¼ yard of Three different fabrics in a "Medium" Value
 - ¼ yard of Three different fabrics in a "Dark" Value
- 45 mm Rotary cutter w/ a new blade
- 6 ½ Inch by 24-Inch or 6 inch by 24 Inch Non-Slip Quilter's Ruler
- 18 Inch by 24-Inch Self-Healing Rotary Gridded Mat
- 100% Cotton thread in a neutral color
- Sewing Machine
- Sewing supplies such as thread snips / scissors, seam ripper, fine sewing pins, soft measuring tape, pincushion
- Optional:
 - Quarter Inch (¼) Quilting Sewing Machine Presser Foot (highly recommended)
 - 6 ½ Inch by 6 ½ Inch Quilter's Square Ruler (highly recommended)
 - Seam Guide
 - Paper and pen/pencil for taking notes

In the **second class**, learn how to sew your rows together matching all corners to create quilt top.

Additional Supplies needed: (none)

In the **third class**, learn how to measure the quilt top, to cut fabric for border and to add borders to complete the quilt top.

Additional Supplies needed:

- Inner Border – 1/3 yard of 100% Cotton Fabric***
- Outer Border – 1 1/4 yard of 100% Cotton Fabric***
- Fabric Marking Pen such as FRIXION Rollerball Pen or SEWLINE fabric pencil black & white lead

In the **fourth class**, learn to sandwich your quilt for machine quilting, to baste the layers and to machine quilt.

Additional Supplies needed:

- Backing – 3 ½ yards of 100% Cotton Fabric***
- Batting 60" X 60" throw size: lightweight, Stitching up to 8" apart, 100% cotton, 100% polyester or blend of 80% cotton/20% polyester
- Even Feed Walking Foot
- 100% Cotton thread in a color that blends with the quilt top
- Basting gun and tacks (available at the Cactus Quilts for use at trial cost) or quilting safety pins (~ 100 of size 1 – 1 1/16")

In the **fifth class**, learn how to make and put on binding to finish your quilt and add a label to date your quilt.

Additional Supplies needed:

- Binding - ½ yard of 100% Cotton Fabric***
- Optional: Sewing Clips such as Wonder Clips
