Fabric Requirements

One panel (2/3 yard) PanelDG-CM3710 Joy 11/8 yards Dona-CM3711 Black 1/4 yard Plaid-CM2281 Holiday

⁵/₈ yard Dona-CM37166 Ecru

¹/₄ yard each:

Shimmer Red

Shimmer Green

Dot-CM9528 Black

 1 /2 yard Holiday-CM1282 Brown (binding) 27 /8 yards backing fabric of your choice 51 " \times 69" batting

Cutting

Label the cut pieces with their alphanumeric designator for easier assembly.

From Panel-DG-CM3710 Joy:

• Trim the panel to $22^{1/2}$ " × $40^{1/2}$ ".

From Dona-CM3711 Black:

- Cut one 5¹/₄" × width-of-fabric (WOF) strip. Sub-cut one 5¹/₄" square, then cut twice diagonally to yield four **B1** quarter-square triangles (QST) (you will use two in quilt). Sub-cut one 4⁷/₈" square and cut once diagonally to yield two **B2** half-square triangles (HST). Trim the remainder of the strip to 4¹/₂" and sub-cut two 4¹/₂" × 14¹/₂" **B3** strips (border 2).
- Cut two $4^{1}/2^{11}$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut two $4^{1}/2^{11}$ x $28^{1}/2^{11}$ **B4** strips (border 2).
- Cut nine 2¹/₂" × WOF strips. From four strips, sub-cut fifty-six 2¹/₂" B5 squares. Set the remaining five 2¹/₂" B6 strips aside for border 4.

From Plaid-CM2281 Holiday:

Cut four 1¹/₂" × WOF strips. Sub-cut two 40¹/₂" C1 side border 1 strips and two 24¹/₂" C2 top/bottom border 1 strips.

From Dona-CM3716 Ecru:

• Cut five $3^{1/2}$ " × WOF strips for **D1** border 3.

From Shimmer Red:

• Cut one $4^{1/2}$ " × WOF strip. Sub-cut twelve $4^{1/2}$ " × $2^{1/2}$ " **E1** rectangles.

From Shimmer Green:

Cut one 5¹/₄" × WOF strip. Sub-cut one 5¹/₄" square and cut twice diagonally to yield four F1 QST (you will use two in quilt). Trim the remainder of the strip to 4¹/₂" wide. Sub-cut eight 4¹/₂" × 2¹/₂" F2 rectangles.

From Dot-CM9528 Black:

• Cut one $4^{1/2}$ " × WOF strip. Sub-cut eight $4^{1/2}$ " × $2^{1/2}$ " **G1** rectangles.

From Holiday-CM1282 Brown:

• Cut six $2^{1/2}$ " × WOF binding strips.

Quilt Top Assembly

All seam allowances are ¹/₄" and pieces are sewn right sides together. Press after each addition.

1. Sew a **C1** border to each side of the panel. Sew a **C2** border to top and another to the bottom of panel.

Flying Geese

2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of twenty-five B5 squares. With right sides together, place a B5 square on the left side of an E1 rectangle. Sew on the drawn line. Trim 1/4" from the seam and press open the triangle. Noting the orientation, place a B5 square on the right side of the E1 rectangle and sew on the drawn line. Trim 1/4" from the seam and press. Repeat to make a total of twelve B5/E1 flying geese units (*figure 1*).

Repeat step 2 with the remaining B5 squares, F2 and G1 rectangles to make a total of eight B5/F2 flying-geese units and eight B5/G1 flying geese-units.

Corner Blocks

4. Sew an **F1** triangle to the left side of a **B1** triangle, along the short side. Sew a **B2** triangle to bottom of unit. Make two corner blocks (*figure 3*).

5. Sew together a **B3** strip, three **B5/E1** units, two **B5/G1** units, two **B1/F2** and one corner block as shown in Figure 4. Sew together and press. Make two top/bottom borders.

- 6. Sew together three **B5/E1** units, two **B5/G1** units, two **B5/F2** and a **B4** strip, as shown in Figure 5. Make two side borders.

- 7. Referring to quilt photo for orientation, sew a side border to each side of panel unit. Sew one top/bottom border to the top and the other to the bottom of panel unit.
- 8. For border 3, trim two **D1** strips to $38^{1}/2^{1}$ and set aside. Sew the remaining three **D1** strips together, end to end and cut two $50^{1}/2^{1}$ borders.
- 9. Sew a 50¹/₂" border to each side of quilt center. Sew one 38¹/₂" border to the top and the other to the bottom of quilt center.
- 10. For border 4, sew together the remaining **B6** strips end to end and cut two 42¹/2" top/bottom borders and two cut two 56¹/2" side borders.
- 11. Sew a $56^{1}/2^{11}$ border to each side of quilt center. Sew one $42^{1}/2^{11}$ border to the top and the other to the bottom of quilt center.

Finishing

- 12. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing, and quilt as desired.
- 13. Stitch the binding strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Fold and press the resulting long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together. Stitch to the quilt front, matching raw edges and mitering the corners.
- 14. Fold the binding to the quilt underside and hand-stitch the folded edge to the quilt back.
