Fabric Requirements:

Other Supplies:

Walking Foot (recommended for the Cuddle®)
90/14 Stretch needle
Long, flower-head pins
Basting spray (we like ODIF® 505 Spray & Fix Adhesive)
Coordinating polyester or poly/cotton thread
Thin, polyester batting (we like Quilters Dream Poly®)
Basic sewing supplies

Brother Bear

approximately 51" x 62"

Cutting Instructions:

From Digital Cuddle® Panel Grizzly Brown:

33" x 45" panel (you should have a scant 1/2" border of green)

From Luxe Cuddle® Hide Ivory:

Two (2) 2 1/2" x 45" strips

Two (2) 2 1/2" x 36" strips

From Luxe Cuddle® Hide Evergreen:

Two (2) 3 1/2" x 41" strips

Two (2) 3 1/2" x 47" strips

From Luxe Cuddle® Red Fox Amber:

Four (4) 1 3/4" x WOF strips for binding

Two (2) 6" x 51" strips

Two (2) 52" x 6" strips

From backing fabric:

One 54" x 65" rectangle

Tip: Cut the Luxe Cuddle[®] from the wrong side with a box knife or scalpel style seam ripper to reduce Cuddle[®] dust.

Tip: Use a walking foot and lengthen your stitch to 4.0mm

Assembly:

- 1. Baste backing fabric to batting using basting spray in a well-ventilated area.
- 2. On front of batting, use a felt tip pen to mark a 33" x 45" rectangle in the center to provide a guideline for panel placement. Use basting spray to keep panel in the correct position.
- 3. Start with the 45" strips of Luxe Cuddle® Hide Ivory and lay, right sides together, down one edge of the panel. Pin well and stitch with a 1/2" seam allowance, stitching through the two strips, batting and backing.
- 4. Repeat with opposite side of panel and remaining 45" strip. Using a

piece of parchment paper to protect right sides of fabric, spray wrong side of strips and press firmly to batting.

- 5. Continue to quilt-as-you-go in the order shown below.
- 6. Baste around entire edge of quilt with a zag zag stitch, then trim off excess backing/batting.
- 7. Bind with Luxe Cuddle® Red Fox. (For information on binding with Cuddle, visit *shannonfabrics.com/video-quilts.*)
- 8. If desired, quilt around bear features to hold batting in place and add visual interest.
