



## GINGERBREAD HOUSE TABLE RUNNER

*Finished Size (Approx): 13" x 56"*

### MATERIALS:

"TREEmendous Joy" Cutie Pattern

6 Cuties (2 for Houses, 1 for Windows/Doors, 1 for Chimneys, 1 for Walkway, 1 for Snowy Roof/Yard)

Background Fabric – 3/4 yard

Backing - 1 yard

Binding - 1/3 yard or utilize your Cutie scraps

### CUTTING:

*From each cutie, cut:*

Refer to TREEmendous Joy Cutie Pattern

*From the Table Runner Background, cut:*

(6) 6 ½" x 3 ½" strips

(1) 1 ½" x 27 ½" strip (sashing)

(2) 14 ½" x 13 ½" strips (ends)

--Cut longer than 14 ½" if you'd like the table runner to finish longer.

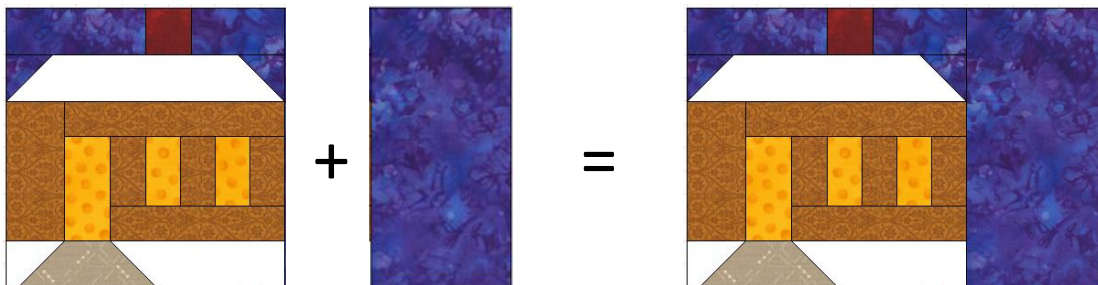
**\*\*Please note\*\*:** Cutting longer will have a direct effect to fabric requirements, increasing your Backing/Binding needs.

*From the Binding fabric, cut:*

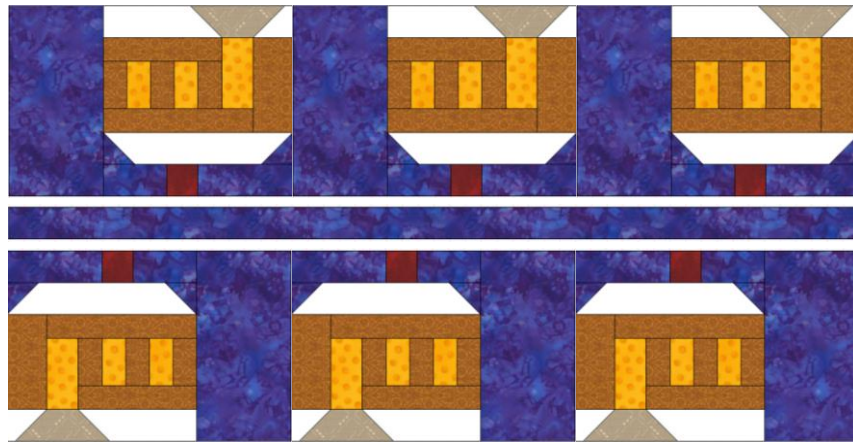
(4) 2 ½" x WOF strips

### TABLE RUNNER ASSEMBLY:

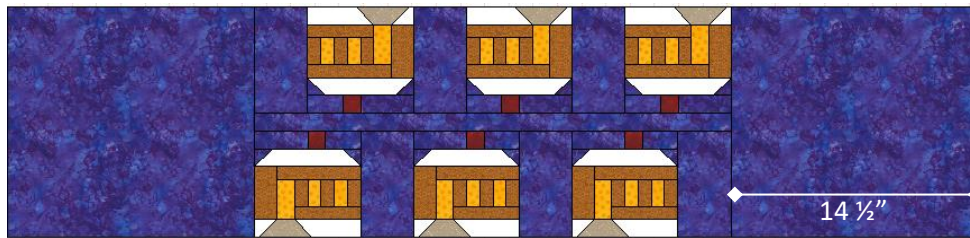
Prepare 6 House blocks as per TREEmendous Joy Cutie pattern substituting "Table Runner Background" fabric listed in place of "Tree Background" fabric in pattern. Attach a 3 ½" x 6 ½" strip to the right side of each house block.



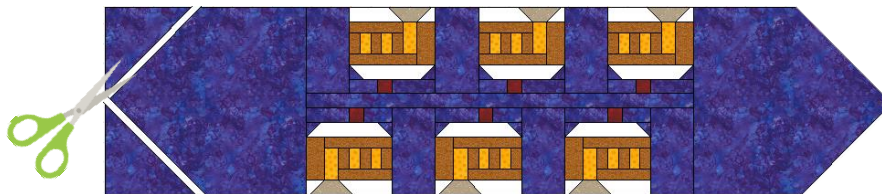
Attach 3 house units together. Repeat for 2 "rows" of house units. Flip one row upside down so that the chimneys/roofs of the house blocks are facing each other; sew the 2 rows together with the 1 1/2" x 27 1/2" sashing strip in between.



Attach the (2) 14 1/2" x 13 1/2" strips to either end.



Mark 6 3/4" from all corners and use markings to trim on the diagonal, forming pointed ends.



Embroider/decorate with hand embroidery stitches, mini rick rack, fabric paint, buttons, etc.

Quilt as desired and bind.
