Simple Drawstring Bag

We chose to make this one with the lovely Mango hand dyed wool by Sue Spargo

Mango Wool solid

No lining necessary, the wool is perfect inside and out! We cut a piece 12" long by 5" wide, folded 3/4" on top and stitched along side 1/2" seam allowance. That's all!

TIP: To stitch the ribbons on the fabric, you can either select a color coordinated thread or a transparent monofilament thread- in which case use a looser thread tension in your sewing machine


