





Pop Stars Runner





All seams are 1/4". Pressing directions are indicated.

Instructions:

- Begin by making the 4-patch blocks. Stitch (2) 2-1/2" squares together. Press toward the darker square. Stitch (2) sets together, nesting the center seam. Fan the seam and press, or press the seam open. Make (4) scrappy 4-patch units for the blocks and (6) background 4-patch units for the setting units.
 

- Create flying geese units by placing a 2-1/2" scrap square on the left side of a background rectangle as shown. Stitch a diagonal line. Trim 1/4" outside the seam and press to the outside. Make (16) units.
 
- Stitch a second 2-1/2" scrap square to the right side of the background rectangle as shown. Trim and press to the outside. Make (16) units.
 
- Stitch a 1-1/2"x4-1/2" background rectangle to the (16) flying geese units from Step 3 as shown. Press toward the background fabric. Make (16) units.
 
- Stitch (2) units from Step 4 to each side of a scrappy 4-patch unit from Step 1 as shown below. Press toward the 4-patch unit. Make (4) units.
 

Fabric Requirements & Cutting Instructions

Stars & Border Assorted Scraps or 1-1/4 yards	(34) 5" squares, cut into (134) 2-1/2" squares or (134) 2-1/2" squares	
Background 1-1/8 yards	(3) 2-1/2" strips cut into (16) 2-1/2"x4-1/2" rectangles (12) 2-1/2" squares (2) 3-1/2" strips into (16) 3-1/2" squares (1) 11-1/4" strip cut into (1) 11-1/4" square cut twice diagonally; from the remaining fabric, cut (3) 1-1/2" strips into (16) 1-1/2"x4-1/2" rectangles (1) 6-7/8" strips cut into (6) 6-7/8" squares cut once diagonally	 
Binding 3/8 yard	(4) 2-1/2" strips

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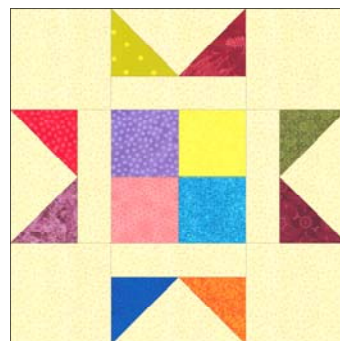

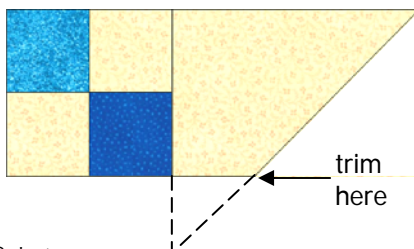

Instructions, continued...

6. Stitch (2) 3-1/2" background squares to each side of the remaining flying geese units from Step 4 as shown. Press toward the background squares. Make (8) units.
7. Stitch (2) units from Step 6 to the top and bottom of the units from Step 5 to complete the block as shown. Press to the outside. Make (4) blocks.



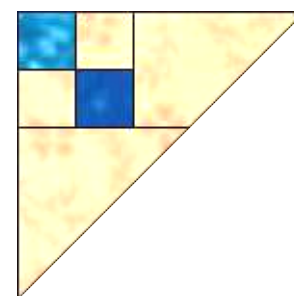
8. Stitch a background 4-patch unit from Step 1 to the side of a 6-7/8" background half-square as shown, matching the right angles, allowing the point of the half-square to overlap approximately 2-3/8".



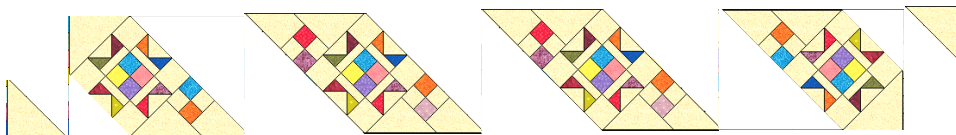
Press toward the background fabric.

Use your rotary cutter to trim the excess half-square even with the lower edge of the 4-patch block as shown. Make (6) units

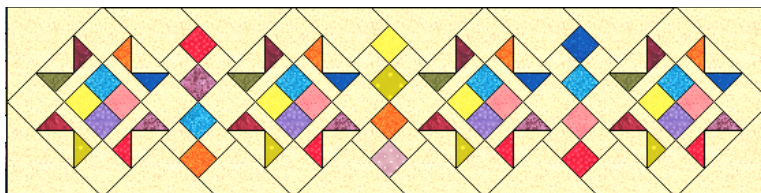
9. Stitch the remaining 6-7/8" background half-square to the opposite side of the unit from Step 8 as shown, matching the right angles. Press toward the background fabric. Make (6) units.



10. Stitch the rows of the topper together in diagonal segments as shown. Press seams open.



11. Stitch the diagonal rows together to complete the quilt top. Press seams open.

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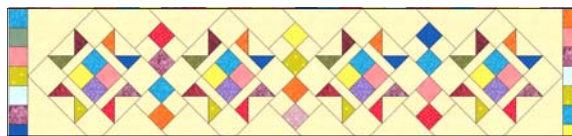

Instructions, continued...

12. Stitch (7) 2-1/2" squares together as shown. Press seams open. Make (2) units and stitch to the sides of the quilt top. Press toward the quilt top.



13. Stitch (30) 2-1/2" squares together as shown. Press seams open. Make (2) units and stitch to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press toward the quilt top.



14. Layer quilt top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired.

15. Stitch binding strips together and bind the quilt.

Background Fabric	7/8 yard (8) 2-1/2"x4-1/2" rectangles (4) 2-1/2" squares (8) 3-1/2" squares (1) 11-1/4" square cut twice diagonally (8) 1-1/2"x4-1/2" rectangles (2) 6-7/8" squares cut once diagonally	7/8 yard (12) 2-1/2"x4-1/2" rectangles (8) 2-1/2" squares (12) 3-1/2" squares (1) 11-1/4" square cut twice diagonally (12) 1-1/2"x4-1/2" rectangles (4) 6-7/8" squares cut once diagonally	1-3/8 yards (16) 2-1/2"x4-1/2" rectangles (12) 2-1/2" squares (16) 3-1/2" squares (1) 11-1/4" square cut twice diagonally (1) 10-1/2" square (16) 1-1/2"x4-1/2" rectangles (4) 6-7/8" squares cut once diagonally
Binding	3/8 yard (3) 2-1/2" strips	3/8 yard (4) 2-1/2" strips	3/8 yard (4) 2-1/2" strips

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
