









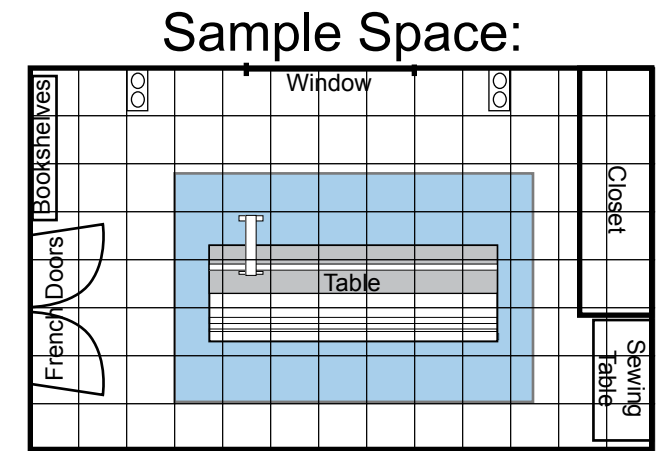
# Room Planning for your Innova Machine

Thinking about getting a machine, but not sure on how it will fit into your space? Use this handy layout guide to determine the best way to set up your new studio!

First, mark the walls and major features like closets, electrical outlets, windows, etc.

Key: 1/4"=1 foot

-  Table
-  Rails and table legs
-  Windows

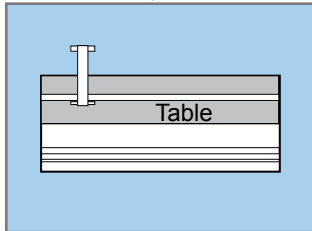


Your Space: 1/4"=1 foot

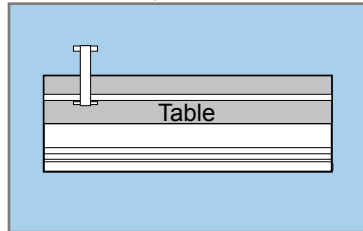
A large empty grid for room planning, corresponding to the 1/4"=1 foot scale.

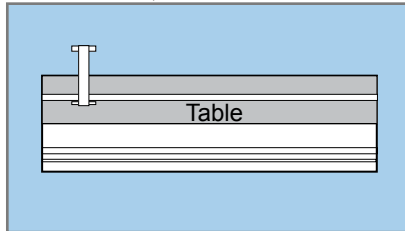
26" Head, 10' Table



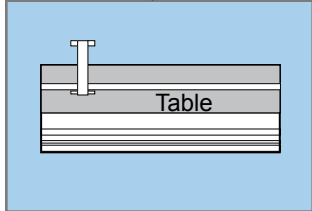
26" Head, 12' Table



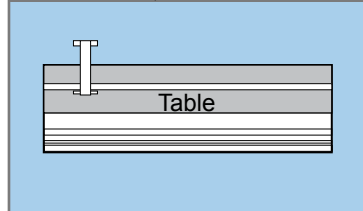
26" Head, 14' Table



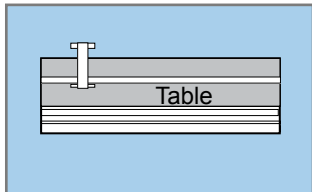
22" Head, 10' Table



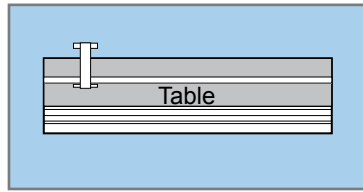
22" Head, 12' Table

If you have ordered casters, you'll need 1-2 less feet in front or behind the table, as it can be moved depending on where you'll be standing. You may also choose to push one end of the machine against a wall.



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
