Regular maintenance is important to keep your machine humming. Here are some upcoming trips, call if you'd like to be added. Signing up for a planned trip means you share the travel and other expenses with others getting service during that trip, which can save a bunch. Your machines work hard, and doing preventative maintenance means that it will be prepared for your busy times! Limited time slots are available, so call soon.

Don't know how to tell if your machine may be in need of service? If you've quilted several hundred quilts or it's been many years, you're probably due. It is cheaper to have us do service when we're in your area as we split travel expenses. You are also always welcome to bring your machine (head and crosstrack) to us. We can generally get to it within a day or two, and will provide the service while you wait and watch.
