9a.m.-5p.m.

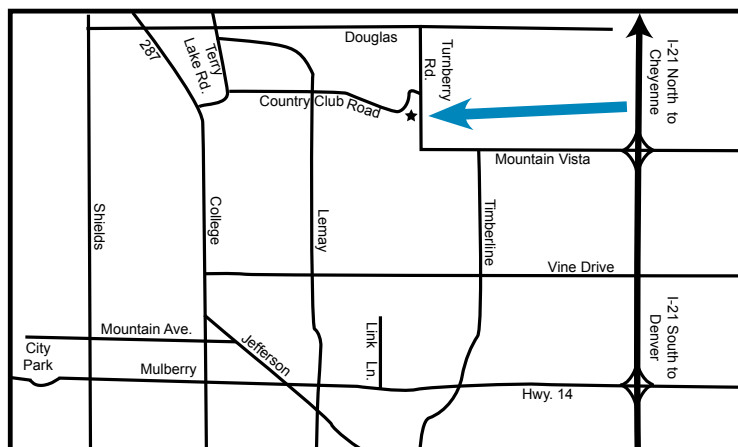

## Northern Colorado Home Show This Weekend!

This weekend, we'll also be participating in a wonderful quilt display at the Northern Colorado Home Improvement Show at the Budweiser Event Center in Loveland, CO. [The Rocky Mountain Quilt Foundation](#) is hanging many quilts, and we'll have a few machines there. Come give one a test spin, or hop on and complete a charity quilt! There will be several of us to cheer you on and answer any questions. We can tell you there is an awesome show special for this event. Gammill won't let us reveal the specifics, but we will tell you it could save you between \$1,000 and 2,000 depending on machines. You have to order at the event and provide a deposit before the close of the show to qualify.

## News for Gammill Owners

Already have a Gammill? We can now do in-home Vision or Statler retrofits, and the price is much lower than in the past. (In home Breeze track retrofits will be available soon.) Call us for more information. Also, if you need maintenance, repair or parts for your machine, give us a holler. We have an awesome maintenance staff, and will respond promptly to your requests. We can visit you, or you are welcome to bring us your machine head for same day service (please schedule in advance). You may want to note that if you have maintenance or repair by individuals not associated with your regional Gammill Dealer, it can void your warranty.

## Classes and Training

In addition to extensive training for new owners, we have many great classes planned for both Statler owners and hand guided owners (non-Gammill owners are welcome). Watch for more information on this shortly. Kelly is also happy to custom tailor a class for you. Let us know what you need (Statler, AutoSketch, a wide assortment of techniques, free motion, etc.) and we can do this in person, or some of these online if you prefer! ## Quilting Services

For the month of February, all quilting services will be 25% off! Yowza! This includes quilting only, and does not apply to fabric, batting, thread, etc. We're happy to provide you with a quote and time estimate.

## Want to do your own quilting on one of our machines?

If you'd rather, you are welcome to rent time on our machines. We have hand guided and Statler machines available. There is a required 3 hour class for renters, and we highly suggest you purchase a set of zippered leads so that you can pin your quilt backing in place before you get here. Call us for more details. If you're thinking about purchasing a machine, up to 20 hours will be refunded if you purchase within 6 months of renting. The three hour class is \$150. Hand guided Vision machines are available for \$15 per hour. Statler machines are \$25 per hour. We will have staff present to answer quick questions, but if you need a lot of support or additional training, there will be an hourly charge.

## Charity Quilts

After you take a three hour class, if you provide written documentation about the organization you're quilting for, we have a limited number of machine hours available at no cost. Call us for more information. We'd love to have this support Quilts of Valor and other worthwhile non-profits!
