Doodling – Border and Sashing Designs will enhance your free motion skills while building muscle memory and solving that question hanging over your head, “What do I put in the border and sashing of this quilt!” Time will be spent on planning and executing even distribution.

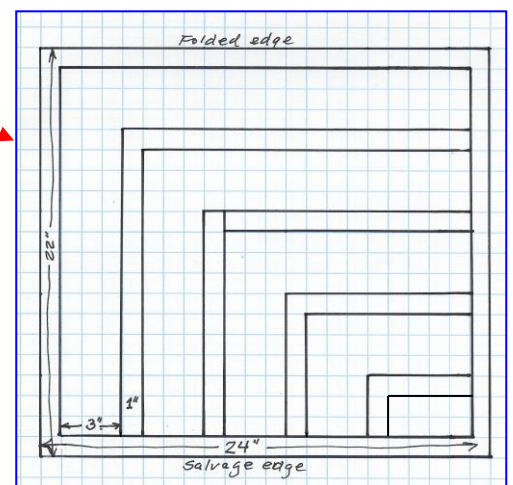


#### For the class you will need:

- ✂ **Downloadable Book** – Doodling – Border and Sashing Design
- ✂ **Handout** - Machine Set Up for Doodling/ Tie On and Tie Off
- ✂ Your sewing machine capable of dropping the feed teeth and the power cord
- ✂ Spring Loaded Stippling Foot - **Required**
- ✂ 90/14 Topstitch or Embroidery needles - **Required**
- ✂ Sew Steady Free Motion Teflon Glider, Easy Slider or Sew Slip - **Required**
- ✂ Machingers Gloves - **Required**
- ✂ Isacord 40 weight Polyester thread, tone on tone to match muslin fabric
- ✂ 9” x 12” Newsprint Doodle Pad and pencil (found at Hoppy Lobby, Kids toys section at drugstores)
- ✂ 12” Golden Threads Paper
- ✂ Fabric friendly marker like Blue Wash away type
- ✂ 2/3 yard of Muslin – Mark the fabric with a 1” space all the way around. Then 3” spaces separated by 1” spaces like the sample at the right.
- ✂ **Nice to Have** - Sew Steady Table
- ✂ **Nice to Have** - Single Hole Needle Plate

#### Prior to class:

- **Before sign in please:**
  - **Print off Book and Handout**
  - **Attach foot**
  - **Thread Machine top and bobbin**
  - **Position Computer Camera so your machine is visible**
  - **Place the fabric sandwich under the foot**
  - **Have a place to draw available**
