
Quick and Easy Five Yard Quilt 54" x 66"



Quick and Easy Five Yard Quilt!

(Color 1 is the dark triangles. Choose the fabric which has the highest contrast with all four remaining fabrics)

Cutting instructions:

From color 1: cut ten strips 2 1/2" x WOF.

WOF=width of fabric

Sub cut the strips into one-hundred sixty 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares.

From color 2: cut five strips 6 1/2" x WOF.

Sub cut the strips into thirty 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares.

From color 3: cut four strips 6 1/2" x WOF.

Sub cut the strips into twenty-four 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares.

From color 4: cut five strips 6 1/2" x WOF.

Sub cut the strips into twenty-five $6 \frac{1}{2}$ x $6 \frac{1}{2}$ squares.

From color 5: cut four strips 6 1/2" x WOF.

Sub cut the strips into twenty 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares.

Cut your seven 2 1/2" x WOF binding strips from your choice of colors left over after cutting your squares.

Stitching instructions:

Color 1: on the backs of all the 2 1/2" squares, draw a diagonal line.

Color 2: leave two 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares unstitched, these will become the upper left and lower right corners of the quilt top.

On sixteen 6 1/2" squares of color 2, stitch one 2 1/2" square, right sides together. Trim 1/4" from the seam line, press toward the corner.

On the remaining twelve 6 1/2" color 2 squares , stitch two 2 1/2" squares on opposite corners. Trim and press as above.

Color 3: Make eight 6 1/2" blocks with one 2 1/2" corner and sixteen 6 1/2" blocks with two 2 1/2" corners.

Color 4: Make ten 6 1/2" blocks with one 2 1/2" corner and fifteen 6 1/2" blocks with two 2 1/2" corners.

Color 5: Make twenty 6 1/2" blocks with two 2 1/2" corners.

Stitch the 6 1/2" blocks into rows, alternating colors 2 and 3 for rows one, three, five, seven, nine and eleven, making sure the

Two unstitched blocks of color 2 start row number one and end row number eleven.

Rows two, four six, eight and ten will have alternating 6 1/2" blocks of colors 4 and 5.

Be sure your placement is correct by following the illustration.

Quilt and bind as desired.
