Quick and Easy!! Good for Beginners!!



Cutting Instructions:

From <u>each</u> of the five 1 yard pieces of fabric, cut: 6 strips measuring 5 inches x Width of Fabric You should end up with a total of 30 strips. See illustration below.


8" 12" 20"

Now, from each of the strips, cut 3 rectangles measuring: 5 x 8, 5 x 12 and 5 x 20 inches
You should have 30 rectangles of each size. There will be extras.

Sewing Instructions:

- 1. Following the layout diagram, randomly arrange the rectangles into four horizontal rows, creating 1 unit.
- 2. Make sure you have an arrangement that pleases you, before sewing. Rearrange if necessary. *There is not a right or wrong way!!*
- 3. Sew rectangles together using ¼ inch seams. Press.
- 4. Join the first 4 rows, forming a unit.
- 5. Repeat the first 3 steps to make a total of 4 units
- 6. Join all units together to make quilt top. Press.
- 7. Add batting and backing. Baste, quilt and bind.
- 8. Binding can be made from the left over rectangles.
- 9. Tip:

Number each of your 16 rows after you have laid them out. You can pin a numbered scrap paper to the first rectangle of each row. Pick up each of the rows in the same order, from left to right.
