


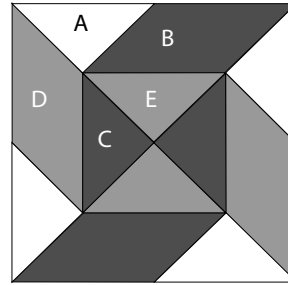


# 30's Sampler - Block 20 (corrected)

Finished block size: 7 3/4 " x 7 3/4 "

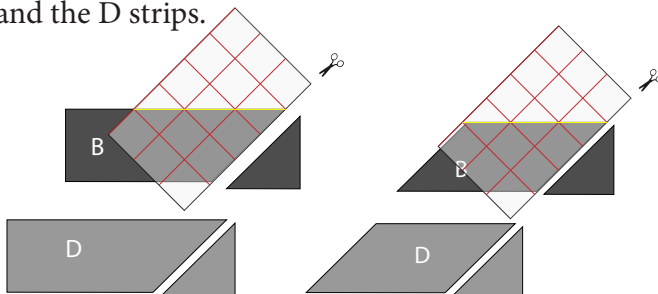
## Cutting

Fabric	Block Piece	Rotary Cutting
Cream	A	Cut (1) 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" Cut twice diagonally to make (4) A triangles. 
Medium Blue	B	Cut (2) 2 5/8" x 7 1/2"
	C	Cut (1) 3 7/8" x 3 7/8" Cut in half diagonally to make (2) C triangles. 
Light Blue	D	Cut (2) 2 5/8" x 7 1/2"
	E	Cut (1) 3 7/8" x 3 7/8" Cut in half diagonally to make (2) E triangles. 

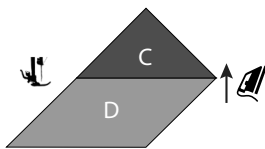


## Block Assembly

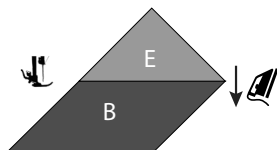
1. Trim one end of the Medium Blue B strip using a 45° angle on a ruler. Measure 3 1/2" from the angled end and trim the opposite end to make a parallelogram. Repeat for the remaining B strip and the D strips.



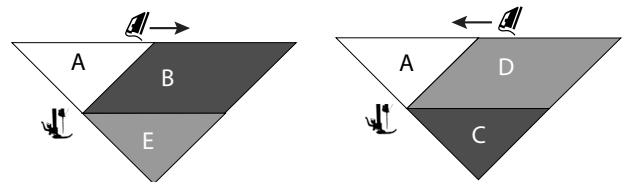
2. Position and sew the C triangle on one long side of the D strips. Press the seam toward the darker blue. Make 2 D/C units.



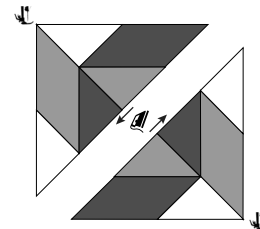
3. Repeat step 2 with the E triangles and B strips. Press the seams toward the darker blue. Make 2 B/E units.



4. Sew an A triangle to the left side of each unit. Press the seams on the D/C units toward A and on the B/E units away from A. Make (2) A/B/E and (2) A/D/C units.



5. Sew the sections into pairs. Press the seam toward the darker blue triangle.



6. Sew the pairs together to complete the block. Press the seam open. Trim to 8 1/4" x 8 1/4".
