"The Random Block Sampler – It's not Random!" Explore the exciting Random Block Sampler in this trunk show featuring quilts and wallhangings made with different size blocks. See ideas for combining orphan blocks into unique quilts or for designing and making your own one of a kind quilt. Pairs well with the 3 hr Magic Triangle workshop or 6 hr Random Block Sampler workshop.

"Just Solids" A guild favorite!

Historically, solids appeared in Amish and Hawaiian quilts, and quilts from the 30's. Today they are popular in modern quilts. Some quilters love solids. Others don't. There is something for every taste in this collection of quilts made with *Just Solids*. See contemporary & traditional examples, and international textiles as you hear Barb's stories about her love affair with solids.

"Big Block/ Small Block"

Size does matter! Compare quilts organized by block pattern and see what happens when you super-size a block or reduce it. All quilts are big enough to sleep under – big quilts with big blocks and big quilts with small blocks.

"Something Blue"

Inspired by the bride's wedding rhyme, Barb's lecture is a study in the color blue. See old quilts, new quilts and a few borrowed quilts – all blue! Enjoy trivia about the color blue sprinkled throughout.

New! "Designing Fabrics/Designing Quilts" In 2015 Barb's first fabric collection was released by Paintbrush Studio Fabrics. In this presentation Barb shares the fabric designing process from concept to completed fabric and shows quilts she has designed to showcase each collection.

"It's All in the Sashings!" Do you have a set of blocks that you just can't decide what to do with? In this talk Barb shares quilts and tops that feature blocks set with sashings and cornerstones. Some are simple and others create secondary designs. See side by side examples of the same setting and study how different they look based on the blocks and fabric choices. Includes appliqué and pieced quilts.

3 and 6 Hour Workshops

It's Magic! - 6 ways to use the Magic Triangle Ruler. Barb's Favorites is the authorized distributor the Magic Triangle Ruler. In this 3 hour workshop use the ruler for 6 techniques and see many samples made with Magic Triangle Units.

New! "The Random Block Sampler" Learn Barb's methods for combining blocks of different sizes into unique quilts. Magic Triangle ruler required for each student. 6 hour or 2 day options.

"Sunflower - Hand Applique" This hand appliqué, needle turn technique class introduces Back Basting Applique while learning to add a curved accent border. 3 hour and 6 hour options.

"Charming Logs" Make 3 ½" log cabin blocks using charm squares. 3 hours.

"Charming Baskets" Make itty bitty basket blocks from charm squares. 3 hours.

"Straight Stitch Machine
Embroidery" Enjoy redwork
embroidery? Finish your stitching in
a fraction of the time using the
regular machine straight stitch and 12
wt Sulky thread. 3 hours. \$15/student
kit fee.

"It's all in the Sashing" Learn Barb's system to fit sashing and cornerstone settings to any size blocks. Students bring their own completed blocks and 'try on' sashing options. 6 hours. \$5/student material fee.
