

#### YARDAGES AND CUTTING

**Note:** WOF = Width of fabric, selvage to selvage.

#### **BLOCKS:**

#### % yard - Plaid (120-14641)

- (2) 4 ¾" x WOF strips; sub-cut
  - (16) 4 ¾" x 4 ¾" squares

#### % yard - Blue Bandana (120-14652)

- (4) 3 %" x WOF strips; sub-cut
- (32) 3 %" x 3 %" squares; cut in half diagonally to make 64 triangles

#### ¾ yard - Red Bandana (120-14651)

- (4) 5 1/8" x WOF strips; sub-cut
- (32) 5 1/8" x 5 1/8" squares; cut in half diagonally to make 64 triangles

#### ⅓ yard – Cream/Navy Horseshoes (120-14612)

- (4) 3 %" x WOF strips; sub-cut
- (32) 3 %" x 3 %" squares; cut in half diagonally to make 64 triangles

#### 1 yards - Navy Horseshoes (120-14611)

- (3) 8 ¾" x WOF strips plus
- (1) 2" x WOF strip; sub-cut all strips
  - (64) 2" x 8 34" rectangles

#### **½** yard − Red Stars (120-14621)

- (4) 2" x WOF strips; sub-cut
  - (64) 2" x 2" squares

#### ALTERNATE BLOCKS AND SETTING

TRIANGLES: 2 % yards - Cowboy print (120-14601)

- (3) 12 ½" x WOF strips; sub-cut:
  - (9) 12 ½" x 12 ½" squares
  - (2) 18 1/4" x WOF strips; sub-cut:
    - (3) 18 ½" x 18 ½" squares; cut in half diagonally twice to make setting triangles
  - (1) 9 %" x WOF strip; sub-cut:
    - (2) 9 %" x 9 %" squares; cut in half diagonally to make corner triangles

#### **INNER BORDER:**

1/2 yard - Blue Paisley (120-14631)

• (7) 2" x WOF strips

#### **OUTER BORDER:**

1 1/2 yards - Red/Cream Paisley (120-14632)

• (8) 4" x WOF strips

#### **BINDING:**

3/4 yard - Navy Stars (120-14622)

• (9) 2 1/4" x WOF strips for Binding

#### **BACKING:**

4 ⅓ yards – Backing of choice


• 2 strips 86" x WOF


#### PIECING THE BLOCKS

**Note:** Use a 1/4" seam allowance for all stitching.

Sew a blue bandana triangle to opposite sides of a 4 ¾" x 4 ¾" plaid square. Press the seams toward the triangles. Repeat on the remaining sides of the plaid square to make square-in-a-square units.

Make 16.





In the same manner sew a red bandana triangle to each side of the square-in-a-square units that were completed in the last step.


Press the seams toward the triangles.


Make 16.



## PIECING THE BLOCKS (CONTINUED)

Stack the 2" x 8  $\frac{3}{4}$ " navy horseshoe rectangles in pairs with wrong sides together. Make a mark 5  $\frac{3}{6}$ " from the ends as shown. Place a ruler on the fabric intersecting the marks and cut the strips on an angle. Cut 64 pairs. Separate the pairs making two groups with 64 each right and left strips.





Sew a red star  $2'' \times 2''$  square on the ends of one group of the strips from the last step. Press the seams away from the red square. Make 64.



Sew the remaining navy horseshoe strips to the cream/navy horseshoe triangles. Press the seams toward the navy strip.

Make 64.




Sew two sections together to complete a corner unit. Press the seams toward the navy strip. Make 64 corner units.



Sew a corner unit to a square-in-a-square center. Press the seams toward the corner unit. Make (16) 12 %" x 12 %" blocks.



### **ASSEMBLING THE ROWS**



#### **Borders**


Sew the (7) 2" x WOF inner border strips end to end. Measure the quilt top through the center from top to bottom and cut (2) 2" border strips the length of the measurement. Sew to the sides of the quilt. Press the seams toward the border strips.


Measure the quilt top through the center from side to side. Cut (2) 2" border strips the length of the measurement. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press the seams toward the border strips.





Repeat the above steps to add the 4" outer border.





From backing fabric cut (2) 86" x WOF. Sew together with a lengthwise seam. Press the seam open. Layer and quilt. Use the (9) 2  $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF blue binding strips to bind the completed quilt.
