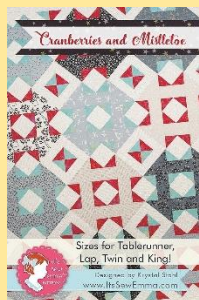

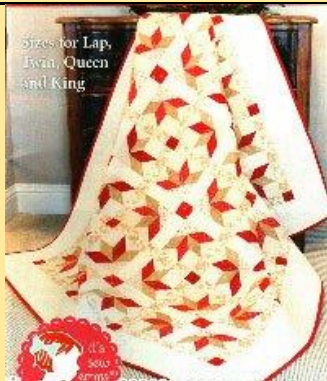

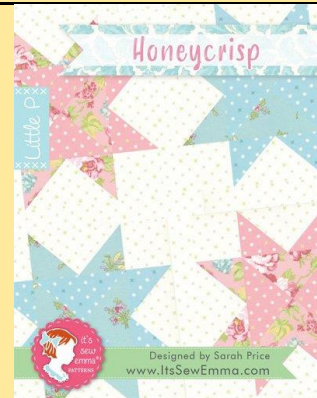

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An EZ Under Technique



Hearts




- Cut four 8" x 8" squares of the EZ Under or light-weight interfacing.
- On each piece of EZ Under, trace around the outside of the 6" heart.
- Cut 1 strip 4 1/4" wide from both the light and dark fabrics.

Sew these strips, right sides together, into a strip set.
Press the seam allowances toward the darker fabric.
- Pin the EZ Under to the right sides of the fabric strip set.
Center the top and bottom of each traced heart on the center seam of the strip.

Notice that two of the hearts lay in one direction, and two in the opposite direction.

- Cut the strip set between each heart.
- Sew along the outline of the heart, narrowing the stitch length around the curved edge and inside point.
Trim, leaving 1/8" around the heart.
- Cut a 3" slit down the middle of the EZ Under.
Turn each heart right side out and press.

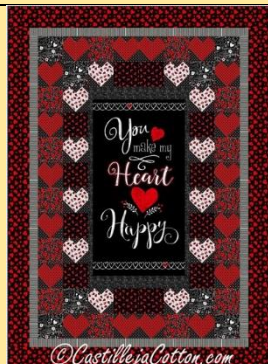

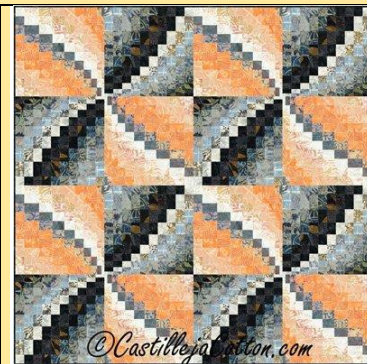

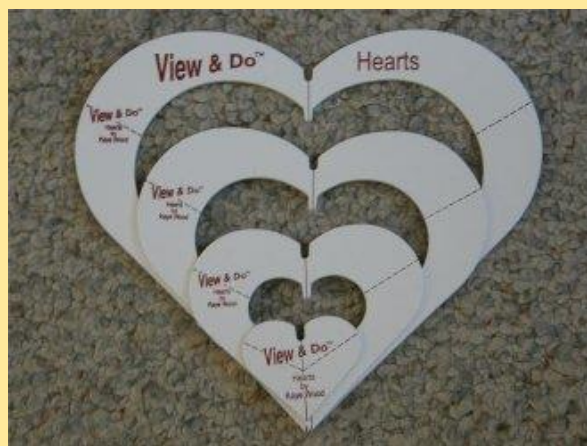
