TOWN PARK RULES

- Park hours are from dawn to dusk
- Glass containers are prohibited
- Alcoholic beverage consumption is prohibited
- Littering is prohibited. Use trash receptacles
- Scooters, bicycles and skateboards are prohibited
- Motorized vehicles prohibited off roadways
- Improperly parked vehicles will be towed
- Two-hour parking for patrons only
- Vending or sales prohibited without permit
- Hunting or use of firearms prohibited
- Plants and animals are protected - do not remove or molest
- Control noise levels – please be respectful of others
- Destroying public property is prohibited
- No smoking or vaping allowed
- Use facilities at your own risk
- Must clean up after yourselves and your pets

RODEO GROUND RULES

- Park hours are from dawn to dusk
- Glass containers are prohibited
- Alcoholic beverage consumption is prohibited
- Littering is prohibited. Use trash receptacles
- Motorized vehicles prohibited off roadways
- Improperly parked vehicles will be towed
- Two-hour parking for patrons only
- Vending or sales prohibited without permit
- Hunting or use of firearms prohibited
- Plants and animals are protected - do not remove or molest
- Control noise levels – please be respectful of others
- Destroying public property is prohibited
- No smoking or vaping allowed
- Use facilities at your own risk
- Adult supervision suggested for children under 12 years
- Animals must be properly contained or hitched
- No overnight boarding of animals
- Users assume all risk of loss
- Must clean up after yourselves and your animals

POLICY ON RESERVING TOWN PARK/RODEO

Cedar Fort Town Park is a public park and can be used by any one on a non-exclusive, non-commercial basis as long as the above rules are followed.

The Town reserves the right to evict anyone from the park grounds (Town property) who is endangering himself/others or who is disrespectful of equipment, rules, or property.

Reservations are required for exclusive small group use, large group use (larger than twelve persons) or any commercial use (exclusive use at the park only includes the pavilion).

The park may be reserved for use as follows:

1. Contact Park Groundskeeper to verify availability.
2. Upon payment of fee to Groundskeeper, the reservation will be accepted.
3. Fees for reserving the park/rodeo are:
 - \$10 / hour (max \$30 / day) for residents
 - \$25 / hour (max \$75 / day) for non-residents
 - \$50/ hour (max \$200/ day) commercial groups

Non-profit organizations may reserve, but no fee is assessed.

Event Insurance (in form acceptable to Town) is required for any large private or commercial group activities.

A \$100 deposit is required to ensure cleanup and return of the sign.

4. On the day of the reservation, a "RESERVED" sign must be picked up by the applicant from the Groundskeeper to be posted at the park.
5. The deposit will be returned after the park is inspected for proper clean-up and the return of the sign.

Town reserves the right deny or revoke any reservation if the Town desires to have the Park/Rodeo available for the general public at the days and times requested.
