

# State Route 73

## RENEWED

Cedar Fort to Foothill Boulevard

The Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) is scheduled to begin a paving project on Cory Wride Memorial Highway (State Route 73) the week of June 25. This 10-mile project will extend the life of the roadway and provide a smoother ride for drivers. The project helps to further UDOT's mission to proactively preserve state roads.

### OVERVIEW

- The project area extends from 200 South in Cedar Fort to Foothill Blvd in Saratoga Springs on S.R. 73.
- Construction is anticipated to continue through August.
- Work will occur Monday through Saturday from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., with the possibility of work on Sunday.

### WHAT TO EXPECT

- All lanes will be open during peak travel times.
- In some areas, one-way flagging operations may occur with one lane, one direction open at a time.
- Monday through Friday from 6 a.m. to 3 p.m.- One westbound travel lane may be closed.
- Monday through Friday from 10 a.m. to 7 p.m.- One eastbound travel lane may be closed.
- Saturdays- One westbound lane may be closed from 7 a.m. to 2 p.m. and one eastbound lane may be closed from 2 p.m. to 7 p.m.

Motorists should expect minor construction-related travel delays. The construction schedule is subject to change based on weather conditions and equipment availability. Drivers are urged to use caution and to follow posted signs when traveling through the construction zone.
