Month Four - Half Square Triangle Blocks

Important information:

Each month a section of the pattern will be presented. Some months you will make pieces that will be set aside for future use. Sew seams with right sides together, using a scant 1/4" seam allowance. "HST" stands for Half Square Triangle.

Remember the zig-zag blocks we made? If you chose to make the darker "background" version shown below on the left, you will need additional HST blocks. If you chose the darker zig-zag, you don't need add'l HST's.

Cutting instructions for the **King or Queen:**

Background

(22)* 5-1/4" x 5-1/4" squares, or (22)* 4-7/8" x 4-7/8" squares

Assorted colors

(22)* 5-1/4" x 5-1/4" squares, or (22)* 4-7/8" x 4-7/8" squares

**If you made the darker "background" zig zag blocks, you will need additional HST blocks. For the King/Queen size, cut an additional 36 of the above blocks for a total of 58 each of background and assorted colors.*

Cutting instructions for the **Throw:**

Background


(18)* 5-1/4" x 5-1/4" squares, or (18)* 4-7/8" x 4-7/8" squares

Assorted colors

(18)* 5-1/4" x 5-1/4" squares, or (18)* 4-7/8" x 4-7/8" squares

**If you made the darker "background" zig zag blocks, you will need additional HST blocks. For the Throw size, cut an additional 12 of the above blocks for a total of 30 each of background and assorted colors.*

Draw a diagonal line on each of the light squares. Match up with an assorted color square, sew a scant 1/4" away from the drawn line on both sides of the line. Cut apart on the drawn line and press to the darker fabric. Square up all HST's to 4-1/2" x 4-1/2". Set these all aside for next month!
