Month Five - Four Patches

Important information:

Each month a section of the pattern will be presented. Some months you will make pieces that will be set aside for future use. Sew seams with right sides together, using a scant 1-4" seam allowance. "HST" stands for Half Square Triangle.



This month we will be making 4-patches. These 4-patch units along with the Pinwheels, zig-zag blocks and Half Square triangles that have been set aside in prior months will be used to create some of the components of the quilt.

This is where the "choose your own adventure" part comes in. In separate pages for the King/Queen size or the Throw size you will have options on how to put the components together.

Cutting instructions for the King or Queen:

You will need a total of 16 4-patches for the king / queen quilt. (no backgrounds, all medium/dark)

Assorted colors

(64) 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" squares


Cutting instructions for the Throw:

You will need either 12 or 16 4-patches for the throw sized quilt. (the difference is one of the throw size corner options uses a 4 patch in the corner. Take a look at the throw size corner options for the "Component" blocks before deciding to make 12 or 16.

Assorted colors

(48) or (64) 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" squares

Assemble 4 patches, nesting seams in opposite directions so the blocks lay flat.
Each 4-patch should be 4-1/2" square.



For the King/Queen you will need a total of 16 4-patches.

For the Throw, you will need either 12 or 16 4-patches. (see throw sized Component piecing page for more detailed information. You will need 16 4-patches if you choose to put a 4-patch in the corners of you quilt.)
