



## 2020 First Saturday Sampler Block of the Month

Month Eleven - King Inner Border &  
Border corners

You will **ONLY** make these inner border blocks IF you are making the **KING** size quilt.

### Cutting instructions:

Background (the light fabric, as shown in this picture):

Cut:

- (32) 2" x 20-1/2" rectangles
- (80) 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" squares
- (8) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles
- (8) 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" squares
- (12) 1-1/2" x 1-1/2" squares

Accent fabrics (various colors, as shown in the picture below and on second page):

Cut:

- (80) 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" squares
- (8) 1-1/2" x 1-1/2" squares
- (4) 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" squares

For the side border units:

Assemble 5 dark and 5 background 2-1/2" squares in a row, alternating dark and light.



Sew a 2" x 20-1/2" strip lengthwise along each long edge. Press towards the long strips.


Make a total of 16 Inner border units, each should be 5-1/2" x 20-1/2".

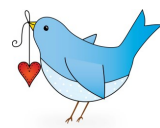


Sew four sets together, at the short ends, making sure that each set is in the same direction, so that light and dark blocks alternate.

Each strip should be 5-1/2" x 80-1/2"

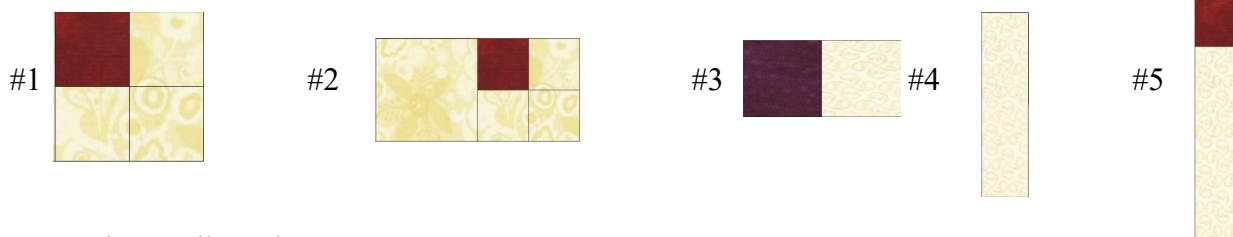

For each of the four border corner units you'll need to piece the following units:

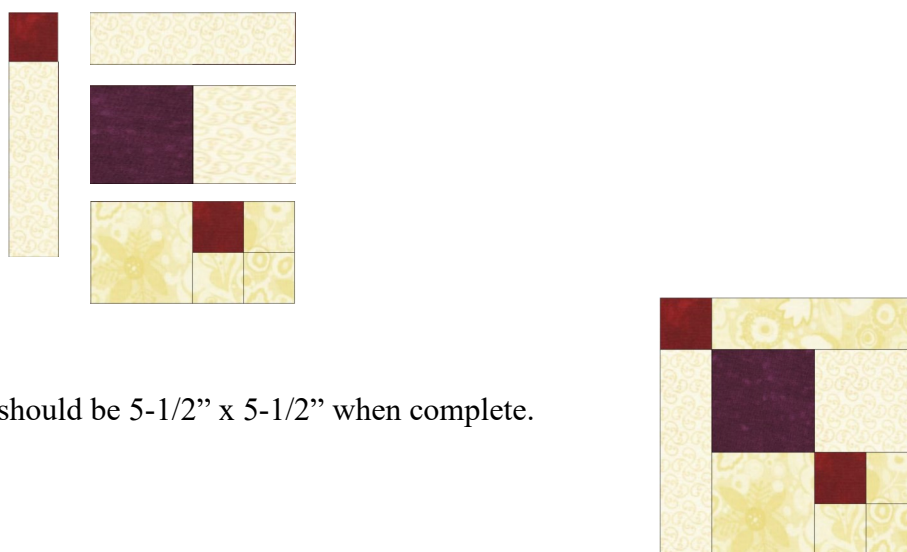
Make four of each. Pay close attention to #2 and #3 as they are opposite.



For each, you'll need:

#1	#2	#3	#4	#5
Accent: (1) 1-1/2" x 1-1/2"	(1) four-patch from step one.	Bkgd: (1) 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" square	Bkgd: (1) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle	Bkgd: (1) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle
Bkgd: (3) 1-1/2" x 1-1/2"	Bkgd: (1) 2-1/2" square	Accent: (1) 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" square		Accent: (1) 1-1/2" x 1-1/2" square

Once you have the components of the inner border corner units done, assemble as follows:



Each of the corner units should be 5-1/2" x 5-1/2" when complete.
