

RESOLUTION NO. 2017-01
LANE COUNTY, KANSAS

WHEREAS, numerous parcels of real estate have been sold and bid in by the county at delinquent tax sales held in September 2013 and prior years and have remained unredeemed on the 1st day of September of the 2nd year thereafter, or third year thereafter in the case of homestead properties bid in by the county in September, 2012 and prior years; and


WHEREAS, the Legislature has passed laws providing for the foreclosure of tax liens and the sale of real property in order to assist the collection of delinquent taxes.

IT, THEREFORE, HEREBY RESOLVED, by the duly elected Board of county Commissioners that a judicial foreclosure and sale of all real estate tax liens be held and that Lane County Attorney Dale E. Pike, is hereby ordered to prepare the necessary Petitions or Orders to have a tax sale of all real property which has been sold to the county for taxes and which have remained unredeemed as of the 1st day of September 2016 for at least two years after such sale as to most property and as to homestead property for at least three years after such sale date, pursuant to K.S.A. 79-2801 and 79-2401(a).


