

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-09

WHEREAS, the Governor of Kansas issued Executive Order No. 20-59 and,

WHEREAS such order in paragraph 7 references enforcement at the discretion of County Attorneys;

WHEREAS Kansas law authorizes the Board of County Commissioners to issue orders relating to public health that include provisions that are less stringent than the provisions of an executive order effective statewide issued by the Governor; and,


WHEREAS as of this date there have been five confirmed cases of coronavirus in Lane County; all of which have fully recovered; and

1. The Board has consulted with the local health Officer regarding the Governor's executive Order 20-59.
2. Following such consultation, implementation of the full scope of the provisions in the Governor's Executive Order are not necessary to protect the public health and safety of Lane County. This Board determines that less stringent measures should be allowed by the schools in this County should they choose to.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOVED by the Board of Commissioners of Lane County, Kansas, sitting as the Board of Commissioners and as the Board of Health of the County, determines that Lane County elects to opt out of Executive Order 20-59.


