Lane County recommendations for COVID-19

DIGHTON-Lane County is taking every precaution for its residents, employees and customers. We recommend those who are traveling practice social distancing for 14 days after arrival home:

1. Wash your hands. Often.
2. Stay at home away from gatherings of more than 50 people
3. Stay at least 6 feet away from people if possible.
4. Monitor your symptoms.
5. Clean and disinfect surfaces daily.

Lane County advises the public to not attend gatherings of more than 50 people at this time. We will keep you informed of changes as they come in. PLEASE familiarize yourself with the guidelines set by CDC and KDHE.

Lane County Treasurer's Office will be limiting access to patrons. Please call to make an appointment, use the online services/mail system or use the drop box to place vehicle renewals or tax payments; located by the Treasurer's office door in the Courthouse second floor.

Citing emergency declarations by Governor Laura Kelly, President Donald Trump and the World Health Organization, the Kansas Corporation Commission used its emergency powers to issue an order suspending utility disconnects for nonpayment until April 15. The action, taken in a special meeting this morning, will offer relief to those experiencing potential hardship from the COVID-19 virus.

We have complete confidence in the recommendations made by our local, State and Federal health officials. The health and safety of students, staff and families of USD 482 is our top concern.
