DIGHTON-Lane County advises the public to not attend gatherings of more than 10 people at this time and to practice social distancing. We will keep you informed of changes as they come in. PLEASE familiarize yourself with the guidelines set by CDC and KDHE.

Lane County Offices will be closed to the public until further notice to take preventative measures designed to reduce the spread of Coronavirus. County Offices will be able to conduct daily business. Please contact the appropriate office by phone, e-mail, mail or online for your needs.

There have been no confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Lane County at this time.

Lane County Commission enforces Governor Laura Kelly's response efforts pertaining to "operate or maintain gas stations and associated convenience stores" that they are not allowed to have ten (10) or more people inside the building at one time.
