Lane County Guidelines for COVID-19

DIGHTON-Effective Immediately, Lane County Commissioners will adopt Phase Three of Governor Laura Kelly's Ad Astra: A Plan to Reopen Kansas **with exceptions**.

Phase Three begins May 27, 2020 and ending on or before June 15, 2020.

- Limitation of mass gatherings of no more than 100 individuals are not recommended.
- Individuals must adhere to personal hygiene guidelines and are responsible for their own safety precautions
- Remain home if you feel sick or are exhibiting symptoms and contact your health care provider
- Employers: On-site staffing is unrestricted
- Nonessential travel may resume but follow KDHE travel and quarantine guidelines for travel to high-risk areas.
- BUSINESS and ACTIVITY RESTRICTIONS: All education, activities, venues, and establishments may operate and should follow all public health guidelines.
- Maintain a 6 feet distance from others
- Individuals may choose to wear cloth masks in public settings as appropriate
- High-Risk Individuals may resume public interactions but should practice physical distancing and minimize exposure to large social settings.
- Any Federal restrictions imposed and still in effect must be followed
- Lane County Hospital will remain on lock down until June 15th. No visitors are allowed.
