Lane County Guidelines for COVID-19

DIGHTON-Lane County Commissioners, in a regularly scheduled meeting, issues the following orders for Lane County, Kansas:

- Effective immediately, all previously ordered restrictions are lifted.
- Because the threat of COVID-19 spread will likely continue throughout the summer and fall, the Lane County Commission recommends continued diligence including:
 - Stay at home if you are experiencing symptoms other than to seek medical care as needed,
 - Continue to wear masks and distance yourself from others when in public settings as needed,
 - Disinfect frequently,
 - Wash hands frequently with soap and water and avoid touching your face,
 - Evaluate work environments for safety, continue to telework as needed, and encourage employees exhibiting symptoms to stay home,
 - Follow the CDC guidance for ensuring your gatherings are as safe as possible,
 - Minimize or avoid nonessential travel.
- All organizations planning large events are encouraged to work with Lane County Health Department and Lane County Emergency Manager to make your event as safe as possible.
- Lane County Commissioners will continue to monitor COVID-19 within the County and address any issues as needed.
