

## USE YOUR ILLUSION

### A Meadow Mist Design by Cheryl Brickey

Would you like to learn to Foundation Paper Piece (FPP) or just refine your skill? This is a fantastic quilt to construct.

This quilt class is open to all levels of FPP from the beginner to the experienced. You may learn a few new techniques to use. The cutting instructions in the pattern are excellent and I am sure you will be happy to have them at your fingertips. The sample was made with the black and white, but can be done in any two colors, prints, or even scrappy. I just enjoyed working with the bold contrast of black and white especially with this geometric design. You can make a 35 inch square wall hanging or a 56 inch square lap quilt.

So what do you need:

- The pattern is an absolute must and PLEASE READ IT before class
- Copy your FPP templates at 100% (the pattern tells you how many copies of each page to make depending on the quilt size).
- Paper piecing paper (at least 25 pieces for small quilt and 64 for lap size)
- Fabrics of choice
- Add-a-quarter ruler
- 45mm rotary cutter with extra blade
- 12/80 microtex needles and extras
- 50 wt. neutral thread
- Paper scissors
- Snips, scissors
- Seam ripper
- Quarter inch foot and a basic sewing foot (Bernina 1C/D or 34D)
- Seam roller and/or small iron (optional)
- Pressing mat (optional)
- Cutting mat
- Your sewing machine with cords and foot pedal and accessories (You must know how to operate your sewing machine.)

You may take a 30 minute lunch break at a local spot or bring your own lunch and snacks. We always have fun and get to share information and laugh. Looking forward to seeing you in class.
