

FABRIC ART BOWLS



You will learn the step-by-step process to transform fabric into a 12" art bowl. You'll be following Kirsten Fisher's techniques from her book "Modern Fabric Art Bowls". You'll be making the "One-Cloth Wonder - Bowl 1" from the book, and use the fold over binding method.

Supplies required are:

**Modern Fabric Art Bowls* Book by Kirsten Fisher

*3/4 yard Pellon Fast2Fuse Fusible Heavy Interfacing

***=The Fabric Art Bowls book and Fast2Fuse can be purchased at the Textile Studio by registered students at a 25% off discounted rate.**

Your will need to bring:

(2) fat quarters - coordinating, non-directional cotton fabric; 1 for inner layer

and 1 for outer layer (Kirsten Fisher recommends pre-washing your fabrics. Just a gentle soak

and rinse will remove the sizing and shrink the fabrics).

Sewing machine with a 90/14 needle

Ruler, at least 3" x 18"

Rotary cutter - 45mm

Pencil or marking pen

40 wt thread to match your fabrics, and full bobbin with same thread

(Lucy uses cotton

thread but polyester works great too)

Wonder clips

Seam ripper
