In this workshop you will learn how to tackle the use of color and contrast to create dimensionality in collage creation.

### Background Fabric

- You may want to wait on your background fabric until you have completed your collage so that you can audition the perfect fabric or pieced background for your creation. In class, you will learn what you need to do to apply your collage to your background and finishing techniques, but our focus is on creating the collage itself.

### What to bring:

- Karen K Buckley serrated-edge scissors or other fine serrated scissors
- Your choice of temporary marking pen, fine-tip sharpie or mechanical pencil
- Applique Pressing Sheet (parchment paper can be used, but the pressing sheet is better.)
- Glue (any fabric-safe permanent glue is okay. I use Alleen's Fabric Fusion
- 2 yards - Lite Steam-A-Seam 2 (SAS)

### Optional Supplies:

- Lightbox – very helpful

### **Rules:**

- NUMBER ONE RULE – There are no rules, only techniques and creativity. Please dispose of all the “I can’ts”, I don’t know hows”, and “I;m not creatives” before coming to class. You can! You will learn! You are creative!
